A spring wedding held at a Georgetown mansion during the National Cherry Blossom Festival features many nods to the pink and white flowers, as well as accents of vibrant blue.

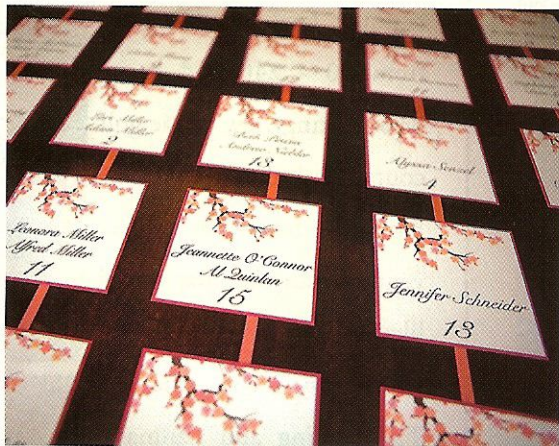

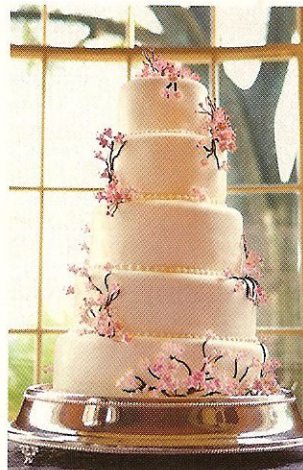
